


U.S. Customs and Border Protection



In an effort to improve the identification of people traveling on diplomatic visas, and assist with resolving issues prior to arrival at U.S. ports of entry, the Office of Field Operations coordinated with the Office of Intelligence and Operations Coordination to implement changes to (b)(7)(E) effective October 18, 2008. This memorandum serves as a reiteration of the attached guidance issued October 22, 2008, and strongly emphasizes the need to (b)(7)(E)


