


Processing of Passengers with Religious, Cultural, or Privacy

Considerations

This memorandum is to inform your office of national policy when processing passengers with religious, cultural, or privacy considerations at air, land, and sea ports of entry. The guidance outlined in this memorandum should promote objective and consistent professionalism concerning the processing of travelers raising religious, cultural, or privacy concerns.

During processing, if a traveler requires special consideration due to religious, cultural, or privacy concerns, CBP officers and managers should endeavor to reasonably accommodate the traveler's request.
