Dear Partner:

Thank you for expressing an interest in donating to U.S Customs and Border Protection (CBP), and for providing aid to the families and unaccompanied children crossing the southern border of the United States. Your outpouring of support continues to be both substantial and admirable and I wish to commend all who have generously opened their hearts and donated their time, as well as food, clothing, and other items.

Recently, I received authorization from the Deputy Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security to solicit and accept items for use by children and families in CBP's care and custody. CBP has identified a specific need for new blankets and books as items that we would like to accept and utilize for the children and families, while they are in CBP facilities. These items must meet the following specifications and technical requirements for donation and use by CBP:

- <u>Children's Books</u> must be in the Spanish language, new/unused, fiction, of a nonreligious nature, and age specific for 0-17 years.
- Blankets must be new/in the original package, machine washable, bleach safe, white in color, without large logos or markings, square/rectangular in size (see enclosed technical specifications).

Non-Profit organizations willing to donate these two specific items should complete and e-mail the Donation Request Form that accompanies this letter to CBP's Non-Governmental Liasion on or before August 15, 2014. Once CBP has received the completed form, we will notify your organization about the number of items to be accepted, as well as the dates, times, and locations where the items can be delivered.

I would like to encourage individuals and others to continue to donate items, such as clothing and toys, to charitable organizations in communities supporting this effort. CBP is not accepting donations from individuals and for-profit donors at this time. They should consider donating to your organization and other non-profit organizations. We have enclosed a list of some of the leading organizations accepting donations in Texas and Arizona.

I look forward to working with your organization. Once again, thank you for your support and selfless generosity as we work together to alleviate this humanitarian situation.
