# The CIS Ombudsman's Webinar Series: 2024 Annual Report

The Department of Homeland Security's Office of the Citizenship and Immigration Services Ombudsman (CIS Ombudsman). (/topic/cis-ombudsman) invites you to participate in a webinar highlighting our 2024 Annual Report to Congress on **Tuesday, July 30, 2024 from 1 to 2 p.m. Eastern Time**.

On June 28, we submitted our 2024 Annual Report to Congress (/annual-report-congress). Each year, our office conducts a substantive analysis and makes recommendations to address some of the most significant challenges individuals and employers encounter when seeking immigration benefits from U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS).

During the webinar, CIS Ombudsman staff will discuss the topics covered in this year's report. These include:

- Looking Backward, Looking Forward: Thoughts on the Future of USCIS

## Why This Is Important

As an independent office, we are not part of USCIS. A key part of our mission is to use an impartial lens to examine the challenges USCIS faces and provide potential solutions. Our work is informed by the case assistance requests we receive along with feedback from engagements with individuals, employers, immigrant-serving organizations, government agencies, and other entities across the country. This year's report offers 33 recommendations to improve USCIS operations, refine processing and policy issues, and address some of the agency's largest challenges.
