- Significant Public Benefit Paroles (SPBP) are temporary measures used to support law enforcement efforts by providing a legal mechanism for aliens (b) (7)(E)

- The issuance of all SPBP is governed by the *Significant Public Benefit Parole Protocols* signed by Commissioner Robert C. Bonner on January 31, 2006. (b) (7)(E) (b) (7)(E) are covered under section 6b of the protocol.

- (b) (7)(E)

- On May 14, 2013, the Office of Field Operations (OFO) automated Form I-94. As part of the automation process, the most recent I-94s record can be accessed on the I-94 website.

- (b) (7)(E)

- Effective immediately, officers should use (b) (7)(E) disposition code when closing out a (b) (7)(E)

- (b) (7)(E) disposition code will prevent access to the parole record on the I-94 website.
