SUBJECT: Updated Guidance for processing US-VISIT Exempt Travelers

The purpose of this memorandum is to inform your office of system changes that have been made to the (b) (7)(E) in relation to United States Visitor and Immigrant Status Indicator Technology (US-VISIT) exemptions.

Previous guidance (dated October 19, 2009) was provided on US-VISIT exemption record matches at air and sea ports of entry utilizing (b) (7)(E)

(b) (7)(E)

Changes have been incorporated into (b) (7)(E) to no longer display US-VISIT exemption records. When a traveler is exempt from US-VISIT processing, (b) (7)(E) and (b) (7)(E) should continue their inspection according to established policy and procedures.
