SUBJECT: Electronic I-275

Effective immediately, Customs and Border Protection (CBP) officers at the Ports of Entry (POE) no longer need to provide hard copies of Form I-275, Withdrawal of Application for Admission/Consular Notification, to the U.S. Department of State (DOS). Coordinating efforts with DOS, CBP enhanced the (b) (7)(E) application in January 2012 to automatically send I-275 data electronically to the (b) (7)(E) (b) (7)(E). The automated electronic process is working exceptionally well streamlining operations for the POEs and DOS.

In addition to the above, this Memorandum is to reinforce the previous guidance to the (b) (7)(E) application Memorandum dated October 20, 2010. The purpose of the October 20, 2010, Memorandum was to direct CBP officers in the field to transition from the (b) (7)(E) (b) (7)(E) within 90-days of receiving the initial training from the subject matter experts. (b) (7)(E) Port Directors are to ensure all immigration adverse actions are generated and completed in (b) (7)(E).

Cases involving Forms I-193, I-407, I-512 and I-515 are not considered adverse actions. (b) (7)(E)
