

The Immigration Court Helpdesk (ICH) is a program available to non-detained respondents in five immigration courts. It is intended to be a live resource for aliens seeking general information for whom attending a scheduled orientation is not an option due to lack of knowledge, timing, or other factors. The services rendered at the ICH are not a substitute for legal advice.

EOIR's Immigration Court Online Resource (<u>ICOR</u>) is a web-based and mobile friendly tool that provides respondents, appellants, practitioners, and other interested parties with a centralized location for resources pertaining to immigration proceedings before EOIR.

ICOR is available in English, Haitian Creole (Kreyòl Ayisyen), Chinese (中文), Portuguese (Português), Punjabi (ਪੰਜਾਬੀ), and Spanish (Español).
