Misclassification of CR Immigrant Visa Applicants

The memorandum is intended to remind U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) officers of the importance of ensuring that all Conditional Resident (CR) immigrants are properly admitted and processed at ports of entry. On July 6, 2010, memorandum titled *Supervisory Review of all CR-1 Immigrant Visa Applicants* was distributed to all filed offices instructing the Directors of Field Operations (DFO's) to establish a local processing system requiring supervisory personnel to review all CR-1 immigrant visas processed at ports within their jurisdiction.



Effective immediately, DFO's shall ensure that Supervisory CBP Officers (SCBPO's) conduct reviews of all CR immigrant visa packets (including derivatives) processed during their work shift. SCBPO's review of all CR immigrant visa applicants includes:




