U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) invites you to participate in a webinar on **Temporary Protected Status (TPS) for Burma (Myanmar)** on Thursday, June 24, 2021 from **2–3 p.m. Eastern**.

On May 25, 2021, the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) published a [Federal Register notice](#) (FRN) announcing the designation of Burma (Myanmar) for TPS for 18 months, effective May 25, 2021, through November 25, 2022.
