SUBJECT: Deployment of Enforcement Alien Removal Module and
ENFORCE 9 (b) (7)(E)

Until further notice, Customs and Border Protection (CBP) officers and supervisors are not to engage in the usage or training of the Enforcement Alien Removal Module (EARM) and ENFORCE 9.

On August 11, 2008 the Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), Detention and Removal Office (DRO) will bring on-line the EARM that will replace the functionality of the Deportable Alien Control System (DACS). Starting on August 7th through 9th, 2008, DACS will be (b) (7)(E) (b) (7)(E). Upon successful migration of the data from DACS to the Enforce Integrated Database (EID), the EARM data will be (b) (7)(E) (b) (7)(E).

The EARM is a new web based portal and is configured to interact with ENFORCE 9. (b) (7)(E)
