The new website makes the process of applying for an ESTA more user-friendly and will improve and better facilitate the experience for VWP travelers wishing to visit the United States.

The redesigned website will launch on September 10, 2015, and has new and improved functionality and navigation capabilities in addition to its new look displaying U.S. landmarks. Some of the new and updated features include:

- · Access to frequently asked questions at any time during the application process.
- Mobile-friendly design allows VWP visitors to apply and check the status of their ESTA using their smartphones.
- Users will be able to translate the page into a different language at any point in the application by choosing one of the 23 languages in the language selector.
- The Group feature has been moved to the beginning of the application process making it easier for families and groups to submit their applications at once.

The redesigned website is a change to the front end design and user experience only. No changes have been made to ESTA Vetting or ESTA policy. VWP visitors who have already applied for an ESTA using the old site will be able to access their ESTA on the new site.
