Jurisdictions calculate CLE credit based on either a 50-minute or a 60-minute hour. Please find your jurisdiction in the lists below to determine how credits are calculated and rounded.

To determine the number of credits earned for a program, please make note of the total number of minutes you actually attended and plug that number into the appropriate equation below.

**50-Minute State:** \_\_\_\_\_ total minutes  $\div$  50 = \_\_\_\_\_ total credits

**60-Minute State:** \_\_\_\_\_ total minutes  $\div$  60 = \_\_\_\_\_ total credits

## **Example:**

Jane Doe is an attorney in Pennsylvania. She attended every session at a conference. There were six sessions: two were 75 minutes each in length and four were 60 minutes each.

75 + 75 + 60 + 60 + 60 + 60 = 390 total minutes

**<u>390</u>** total minutes  $\div$  60 = **<u>6.5</u>** total credit
