To determine the number of credits earned for a program, please make note of the total number of minutes you actually attended and plug that number into the appropriate equation below.

50-Minute State: _____ total minutes ÷ 50 = _____ total credits

60-Minute State: _____ total minutes ÷ 60 = _____ total credits

Example:

Jane Doe is an attorney in Pennsylvania. She attended every session at a conference. There were six sessions: two were 75 minutes each in length and four were 60 minutes each.

$$75 + 75 + 60 + 60 + 60 + 60 = \mathbf{390} \text{ total minutes}$$

$$\mathbf{390} \text{ total minutes} \div 60 = \mathbf{6.5} \text{ total credit}$$
