SUBJECT: Implementation of Boarding Foils for Certain USCIS Paroles

On October 28, 2013, the Department of State will implement the issuance of boarding foils in lieu of the present practice of using transportation letters or Form I-512 to aliens who have been authorized parole by U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) International Operations (IO) on the basis of the alien filing Form I-131, or a U.S. Government agency parole request. These instructions do not apply to paroles issued by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) or to paroles issued by USCIS to individuals pursuing adjustment of status and issued Form I-512 for travel outside of the United States.

Attached is a memorandum from USCIS to U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) that provides additional details (see an exemplar on page 3 of the memorandum). If an alien presents a Lincoln Visa foil with the following characteristics:
