SUBJECT: Changes to the SEVIS Login Process

On December 4, 2015, the Student and Exchange Visitor Program (SEVP) will release a software update that will require government users to create a profile in the Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS). All CBP officers with SEVIS access will be required to create a profile upon first logging into SEVIS. New SEVIS users will create this profile upon gaining access to SEVIS for the first time. Access to SEVIS must still be acquired through your local PICS officer.

SEVP is deploying this functionality to comply with Federal Information Security Management Act (FISMA) requirements for users to annually verify their need to access SEVIS, improve SEVP communications with government users about SEVIS system changes and outages and allow government users to reset their passwords more quickly. A Government User Profile User Guide is available for reference on the ICE.gov/sevis website.
