SUBJECT: (b) (7)(E) Enhancements to Complement Section 217(a) of the INA Changes

On December 18, 2015, the Visa Waiver Program Improvement and Terrorist Travel Prevention Act of 2015 (The Act) was passed by Congress, which established new elements for eligibility to travel on the Visa Waiver Program (VWP). This memorandum is designed to complement the January 21, 2016 memorandum, "Legislative Changes to Section 217(a) of the INA," by delineating technical enhancements launched in (b) (7)(E) in support of the legislative change.


To reiterate, travelers may be ineligible for entry under the Visa Waiver Program (VWP) due to:

(b) (7)(E)

The sole exception to the VWP ineligibility is for VWP country official government or military travel.

Consequently, all ports of entry may encounter intended VWP applicants for admission that are no longer eligible for entry under the VWP. These applicants may be eligible for discretion in the form of an I-193, Waiver of Documents, (b) (7)(E)
