Figure 1: Mock-up of modernized TECS homepage

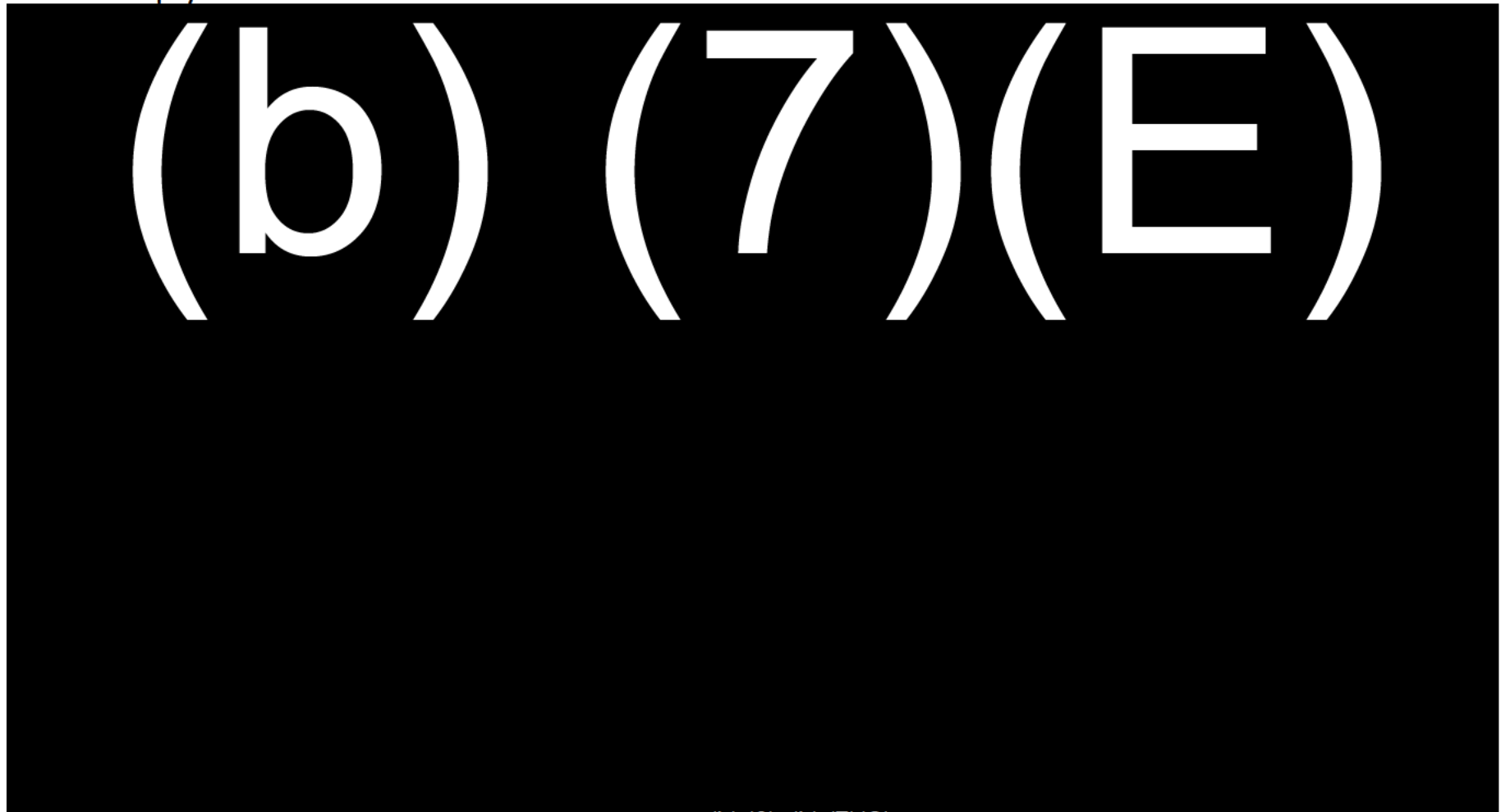

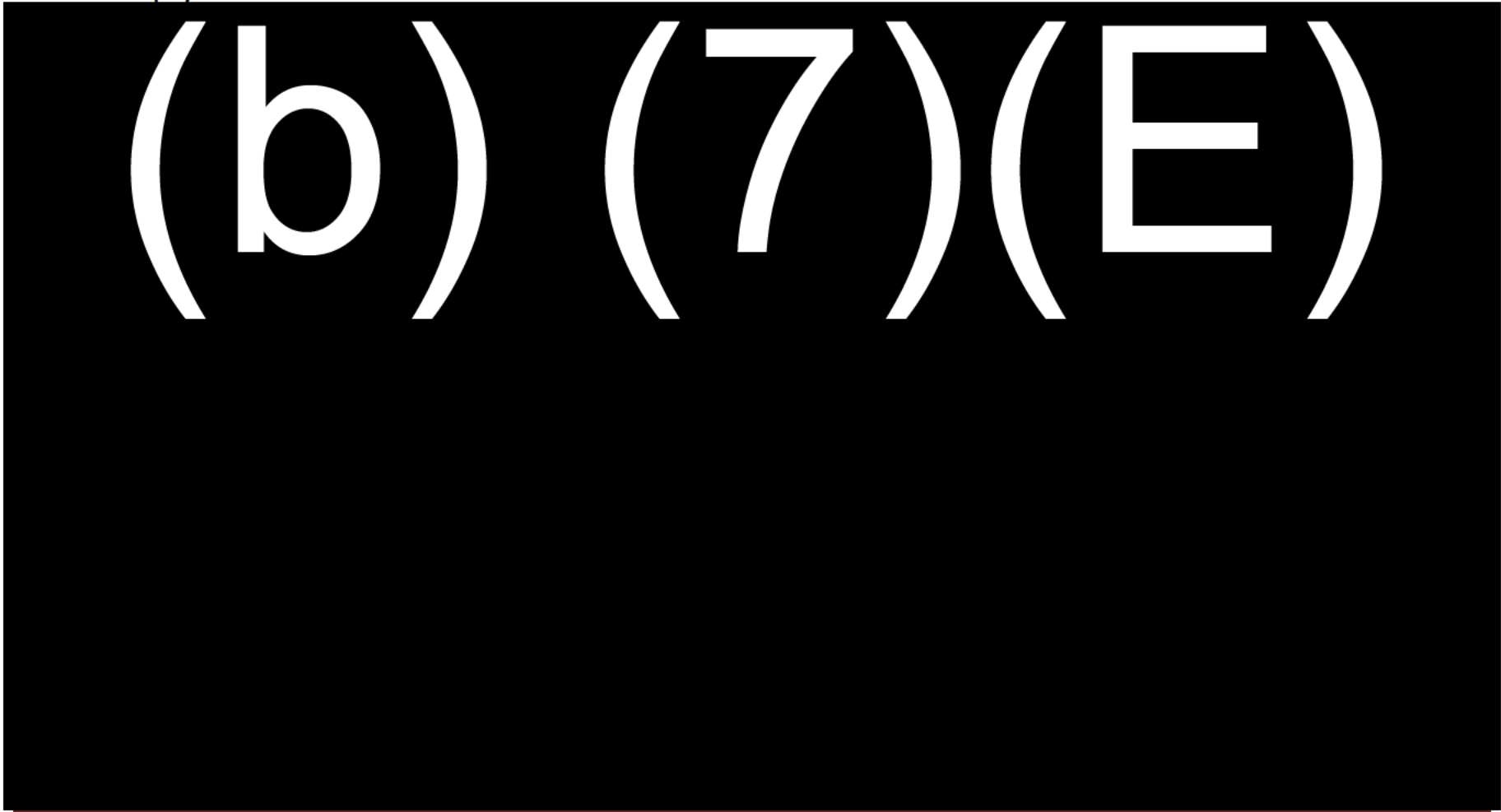
