SUBJECT: Form I-92, Aircraft/Vessel Report

Effective immediately, U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) no longer requires the submission of arrival data on CBP Form I-92, Aircraft/Vessel Report, by arriving air and sea carriers. CBP Form I-92, the record of arrival, departure and passenger data, is now unnecessary for arrival data due to the availability of that data via CBP automated systems.

Departure data on CBP Form I-92 will continue to be required by departing air and sea carriers until further notice. As CBP improves and expands the electronic collection of data, CBP Form I-92 will eventually become redundant.
