United States and Canadian Citizen IBC workers applying for admission at a port of entry should be prepared to present a Western Hemisphere Travel Initiative (WHTI) compliant travel document. WHTI compliant documents include passports, U.S. Passport Cards, Enhanced Driver's Licenses, and Trusted Traveler Program Cards (NEXUS, FAST). Canadian IBC employees on official business, if otherwise admissible, should be admitted as B-1 business visitors. The IBC employees who will supervise the field crews are identified in the attached list.
