SUBJECT: (b) (7)(E) Custody Enhancements

This memo serves as a reminder and clarification of the requirement for electronic recordation of all detention and transportation actions as previously discussed in *Implementation of U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) National Standards on Transport, Escort, Detention, and Search (TEDS)* and *Implementation of Court Order regarding Flores Settlement Agreement*. These documents directed the field to electronically document and monitor actions taken for persons in OFO custody pending repatriation or transfer to another agency.

Accordingly, the recordation of all custody actions or use of secure detention areas must be recorded in the (b) (7)(E) The worksheets for the (b) (7)(E) will be updated to reflect this change for the next cycle.
