Visa Foils Issued for Cuban Medical Professional Program

In an effort to improve travel document security and combat fraud, the Department of State (DOS) is updating their procedures for issuing travel documents to individuals traveling under the Cuban Medical Professional Program (CMPP). Under the CMPP, Cuban medical personnel conscripted to study or work in a third country under the direction of the Cuban government are permitted to enter the United States. (b) (7)(E)

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According to section 212(d)(5)(A) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (INA), DHS has the statutory authority to parole eligible Cuban nationals into the United States. (b) (7)(E)
