Subject: Revised U.S. Permanent Resident Card

On May 10, 2010, U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (CIS) will introduce the latest version of the Permanent Resident Card (Form I-551). The card bears a revision date of February 16, 2009. All previous versions of the I-551 shall remain valid until expiration. U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) officers should expect to see the new Permanent Resident Card (PRC) shortly thereafter at all air, land, and sea ports of entry.
