Discontinuance of Fee Collections on Behalf of U.S. Citizenship

and Immigration Services (USCIS)

Effective January 1, 2017, U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) will discontinue the practice of accepting most applications and fee payments on behalf of USCIS at Ports of Entry (POEs). However, CBP will continue to collect fees and process the following applications:

- Trade NAFTA, TN.
- Form I-192
- Forms I-129 (Petition for Non-Immigrant Worker) L-1. Note: the I-129 fee increases from \$325.00 to \$460.00 on December 23, 2016.
- I-212 (Application for Permission to Reapply for Admission into the United States After Deportation or Removal). *Note*: The I-212 fee increases from \$585 to \$930 on December 23, 2016.
- I-824 (Application for Action on an Approved Application or Petition).

USCIS is standardizing their electronic filing process requiring, whereby applications and fees will be filed directly. CBP Officers should direct travelers coming to the POEs to file an application to the USCIS website (www.uscis.gov) for information pertaining to submission of applications/petitions/applicable fees or to notify the applicant to contact the USCIS National Customer Service Center at 1-800-375-5283 for additional information.



SUBJECT: U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) Port of Entry Collections on Behalf of U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS)

Effective January 1, 2017, USCIS is requesting that CBP no longer accept applications and fee payments on behalf of USCIS at Ports of Entry (POE), with the exception of the NAFTA Trade Canada, I-129S, I-212, and the I-824 forms. This change is the result of USCIS moving to an electronic based filing process, standardizing collection processes, and the requirement for certain applications/petitions to be filed directly with USCIS.

CBP Officers should direct individuals coming into the United States at POE's to the USCIS public website (www.uscis.gov) for information pertaining to submission requirements for all applications/petitions and applicable fees. If the individual would like additional information beyond what is available on the public website, please direct them to the USCIS National Customer Service Center by calling 1-800-375-5283.

As noted above, USCIS is requesting that CBP continue accepting the following applications/petitions and fees at the POE's and provide USCIS with the supporting deposit information:

- NAFTA Trade Canada
- I-129S Nonimmigrant Petition Based on Blanket L Petition
- I-212 Application for Permission to Reapply for Admission into the United States After Deportation or Removal
- I-824 Application for Action on an Approved Application or Petition

The continuation of CBP accepting these applications/petitions and fees is based on statutory regulations, a previous approval, or CBP having jurisdiction.
