SUBJECT: Temporary Suspension of Separation Actions Pertaining to Members of the Delayed Entry Program (DEP) and Delayed Training Program (DTP) Recruited Through the Military Accessions Vital to National Interest (MAVNI) Pilot Program

- 1. You are requested to review the administrative separation procedures applicable to members of the Delayed Entry Program (DEP) and Delayed Training Program (DTP) who were recruited through the Military Accessions Vital to National Interest (MAVNI) Pilot Program and provide recommendations to me concerning the need to issue additional or clarifying guidance. As part of this review, you will also develop a notification procedure to ensure that I am advised of a final separation determination before separation occurs.
- 2. Effective immediately, you will suspend processing of all involuntary separation actions pertaining to members of the DEP and the DTP who were recruited through the MAVNI Pilot Program.
- 3. Please coordinate your recommendations with the DASA-MPQ, OCLL, and OCPA and provide them to me no later than 15 August 2018.
