CANCELLATION OF CERTAIN OPERATING POLICIES AND PROCEDURES MEMORANDA

PURPOSE: Rescinds and cancels outdated Operating Policies and Procedures

Memoranda

OWNER: Office of the Director

AUTHORITY: 8 C.F.R. § 1003.0(b)

CANCELLATION: Operating Policies and Procedures Memoranda 96-4 and 99-4.

As part of the Executive Office for Immigration Review's ongoing efforts to improve operations and review existing policy memoranda, the following Operating Policies and Procedures Memoranda (OPPM) issued by the Office of the Chief Immigration Judge (OCIJ) are rescinded:

- 1. OPPM 96-4, Processing of Motions and Appeals
- 2. OPPM 99-4, Electronic I-830 (Notice to EOIR: Alien Address)

These OPPM were each issued over two decades ago and have become outdated or unnecessary in the intervening years. OCIJ, in consultation with the Office of the Director, will determine if any future guidance becomes necessary regarding the topics covered in the rescinded OPPM.
